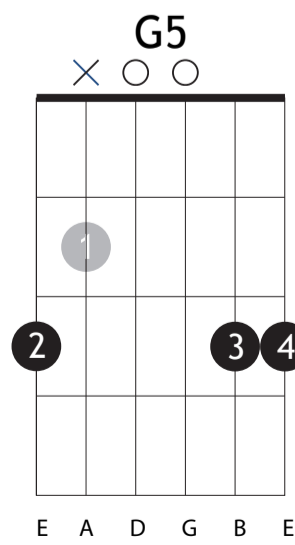
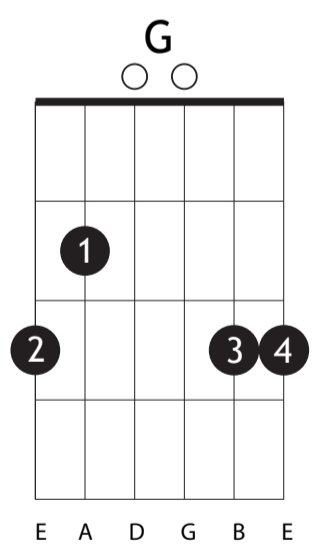
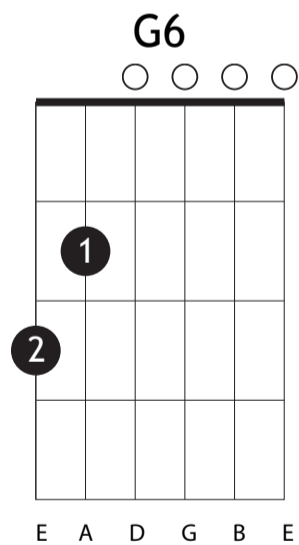
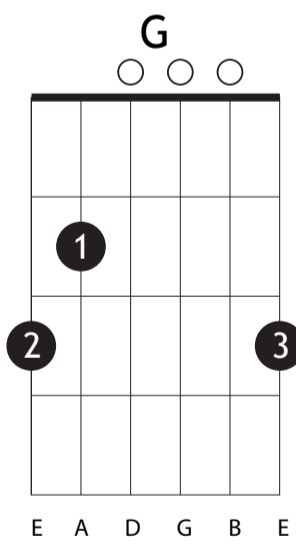
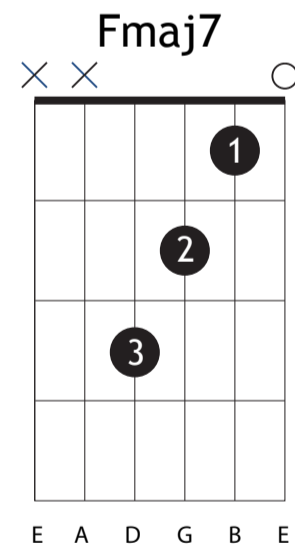
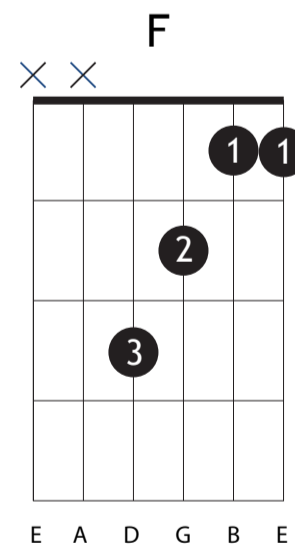
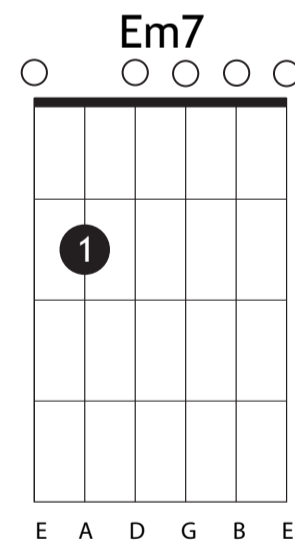
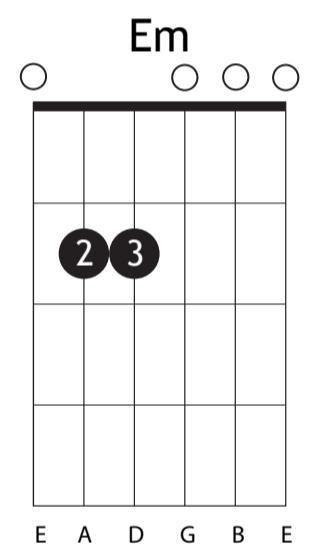
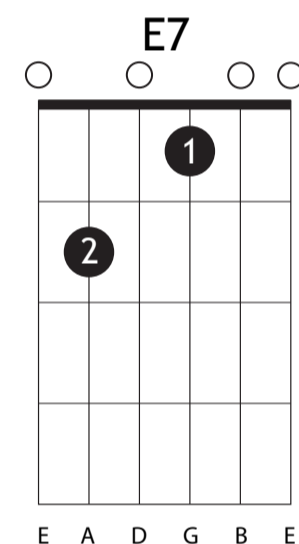
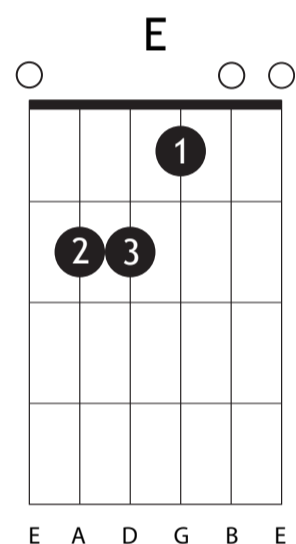
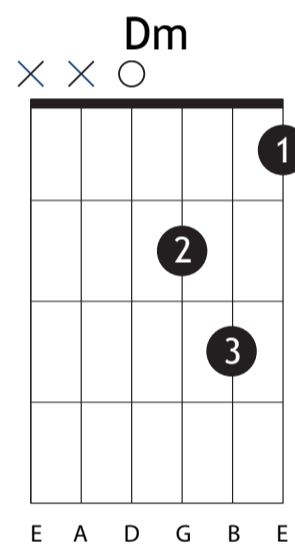
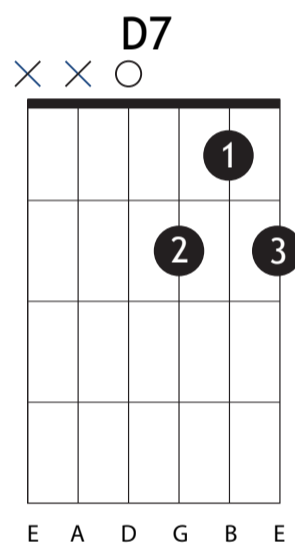
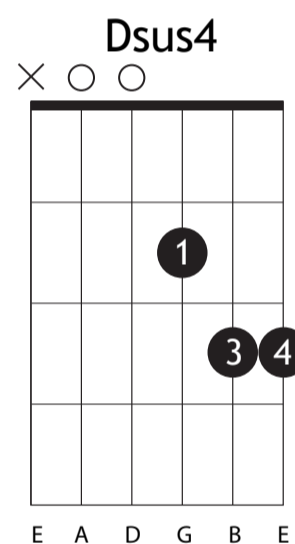
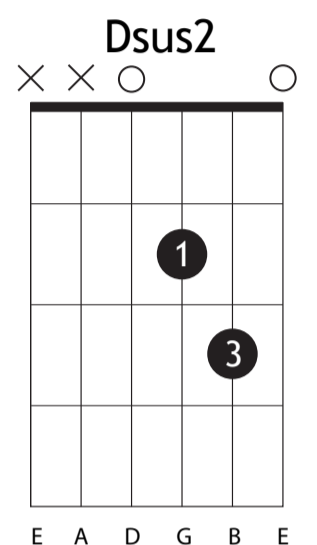
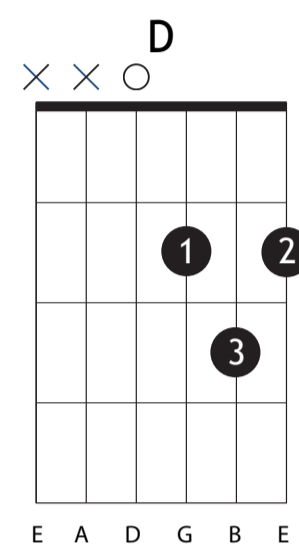
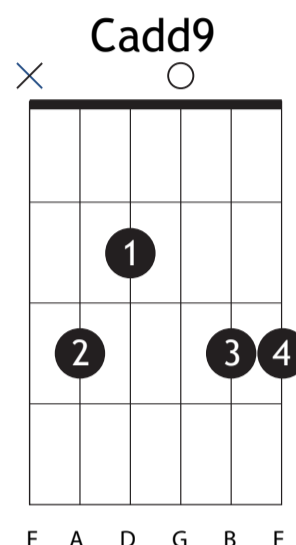
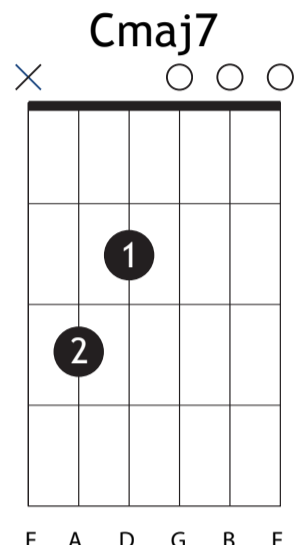
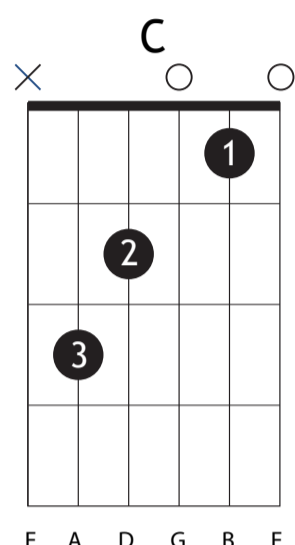
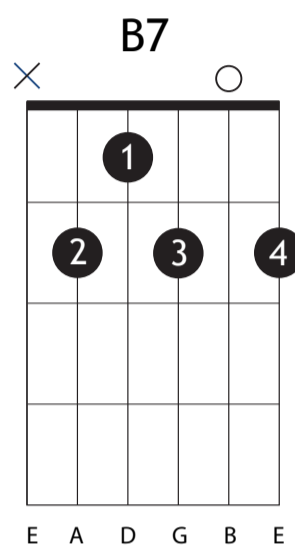
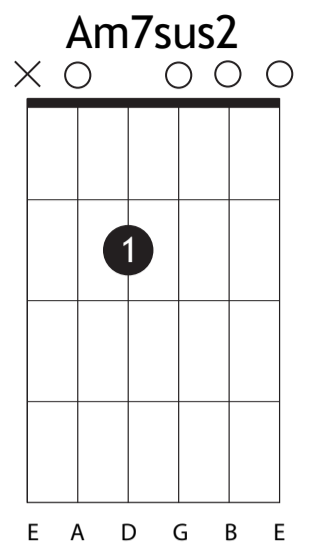
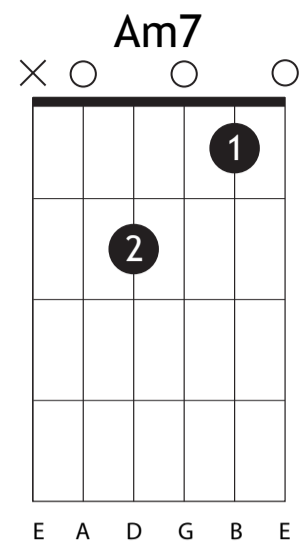
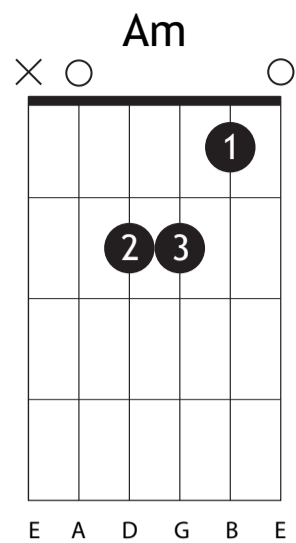
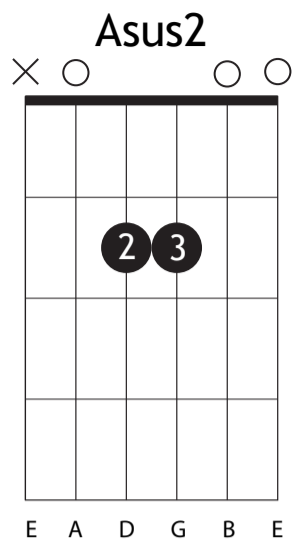
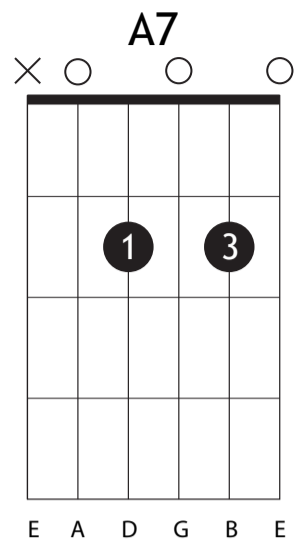
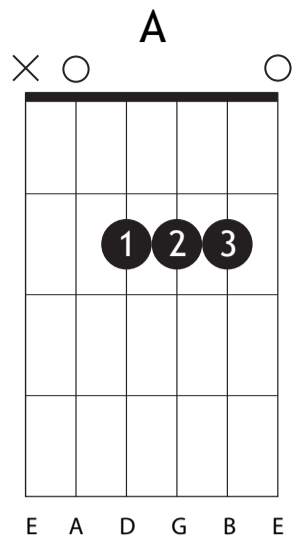


Beginners Guitar Chords

A, Asus2, A7

C, Cmaj7 (I call this 'easy C'), Cadd9

Dm, Dsus2, Dsus4

Em, Em7

G, G6 ('Easy G')

Am, Asus2, Am7, Am7sus2

D, Dsus2, Dsus4, D7

E, E7

F, Fmaj7 (I call this one 'Easy F')

G5 is used instead of Gm (a grade 3 chord).
